MA Screenwriting

We are now able to offer two screenwriting bursaries for our one-year MA Screenwriting programme for September 2011 entry. **Therefore we have extended the deadline to 1st July.** UK qualifying applicants are invited to apply for the bursaries, which will be means-tested and offer contributions to course fees and cost of living allowances.

The MA Screenwriting is a unique one-year screenwriting course within the context of a diverse filmmaking community. The emphasis is on developing the writer's original voice through small group and one-to-one mentoring from industry professionals, with the core practical activity the development of a feature screenplay. Bringing together recent thinking about curating contemporary art with the constantly evolving world of film, film festivals and the movie business, it offers an exploration into the role of film curating in an age in which digital distribution technologies are transforming both the traditional notion of curating and the commercial film distribution sector. A key attraction of the programme is the privileged access that students have to established film festivals and attendance at least two festivals is included in the fee (Cannes and Rotterdam in 2010-2011).
